

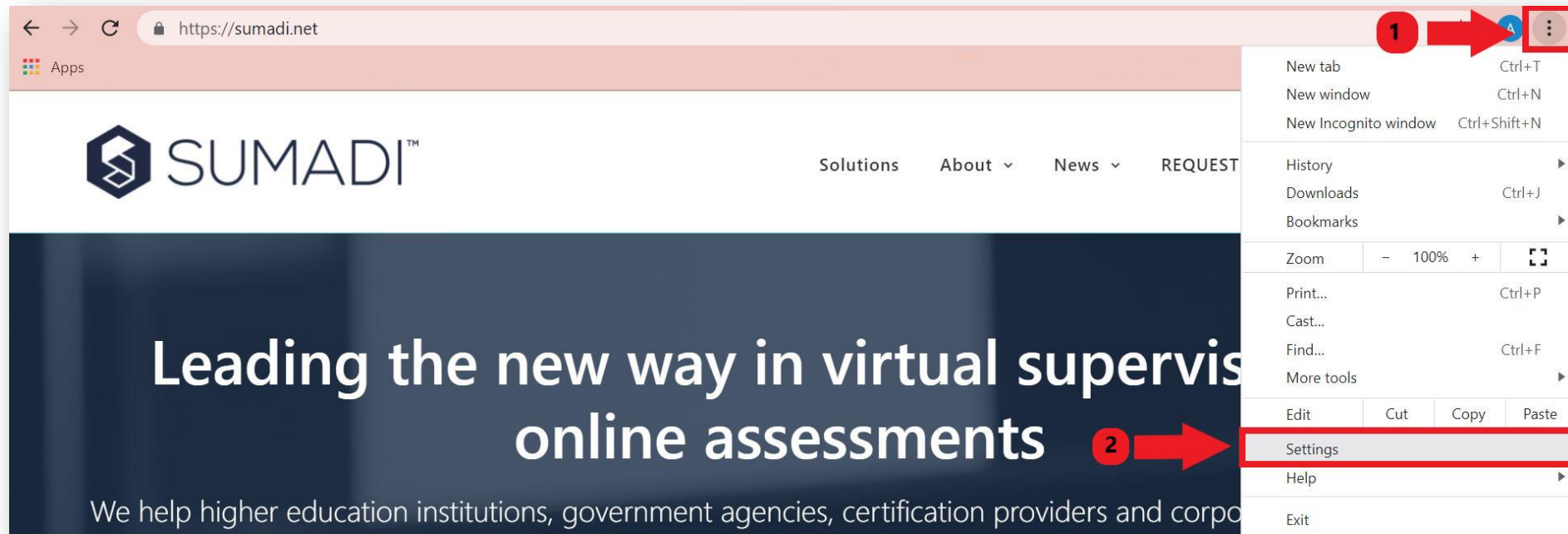
Set up and enable your camera in Google Chrome



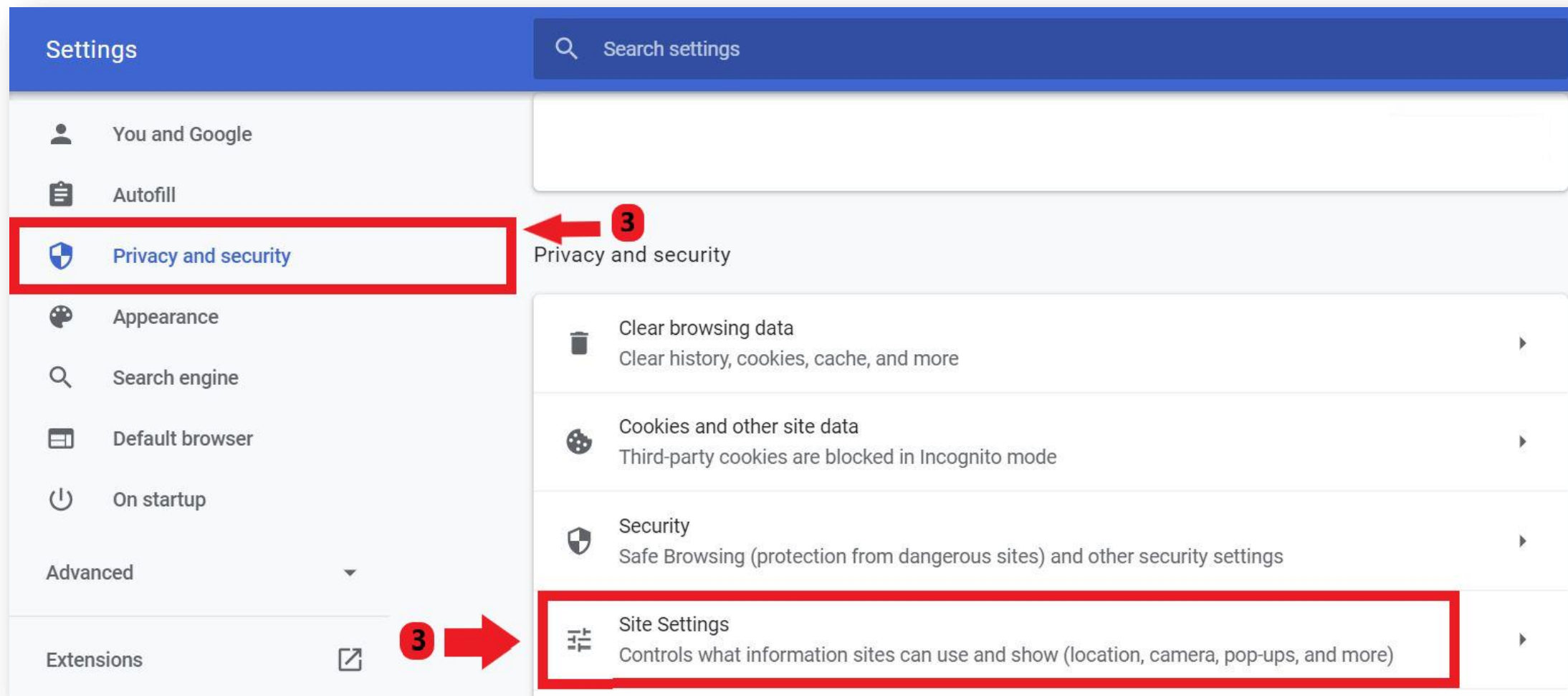
Your camera must be set up before performing your face registration.

It is very important that you do not use or select a virtual or IR camera, such as **Snapcamera, DroidCam, Iriun webcam, etc.**

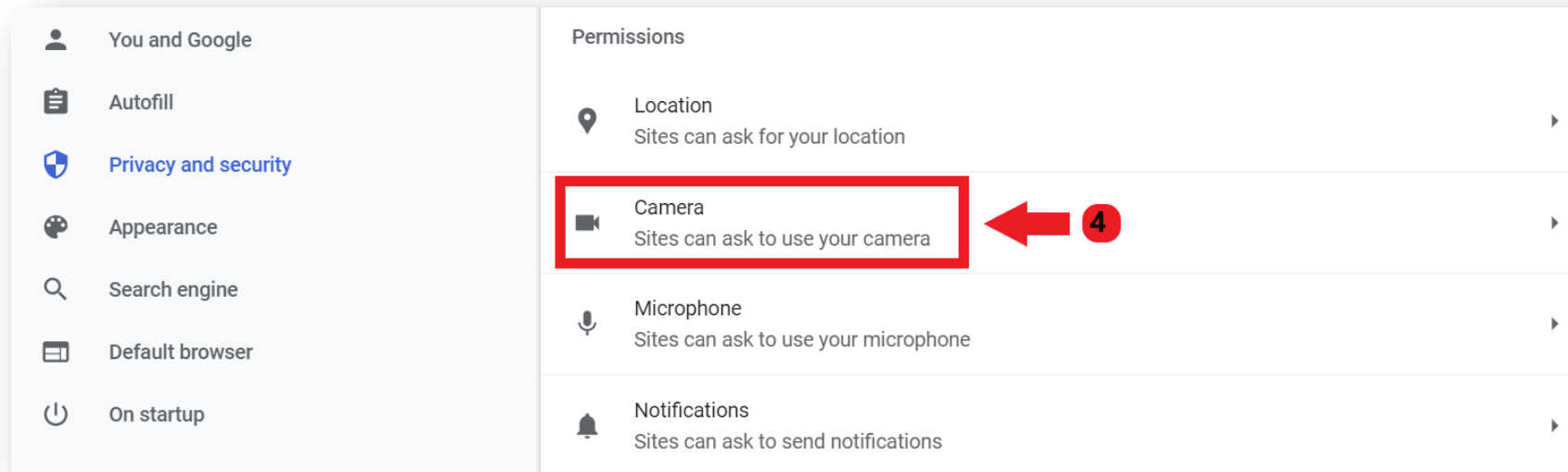
- 1 Go to the three dots menu located in the upper right corner.
- 2 Click on "**Settings**".



- 3 Search for the "Privacy and Security" section and click on the "Site Settings" option.




4 Search for the "Camera" section.



5 In the available cameras' menu, select your computer's built-in/integrated camera (make sure it's not a virtual or IR one).



If you have not given SUMADI™ permissions to access or disable the camera, a modal window will display asking you to enable it.
