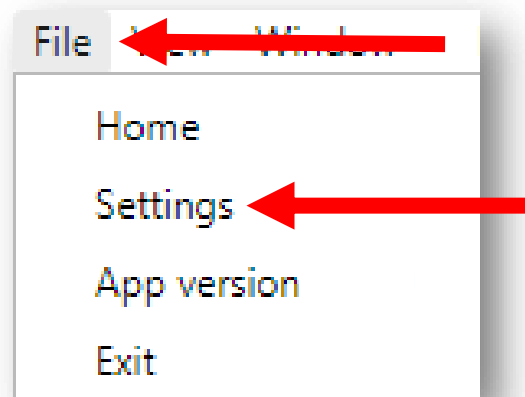


Camera and Microphone configuration SUMADI V2 - Windows



Camera Configuration

- 1 Click the **File** button on the toolbar located in the upper left corner of the SUMADI™ app.
- 2 Click on the **Settings** option.



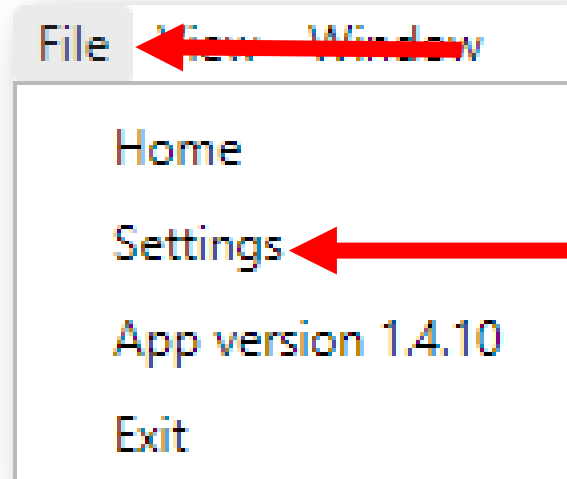
3 Select the integrated camera in your computer.

3 Select the microphone connected to your computer.



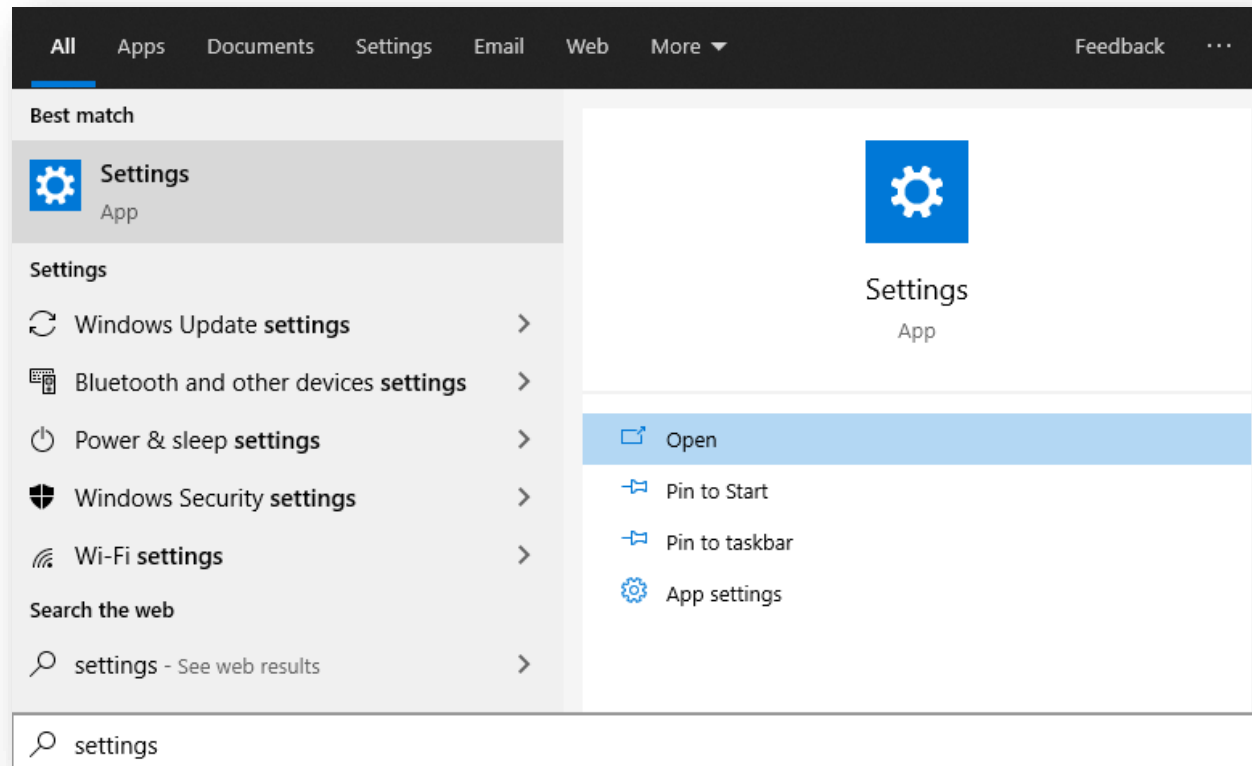

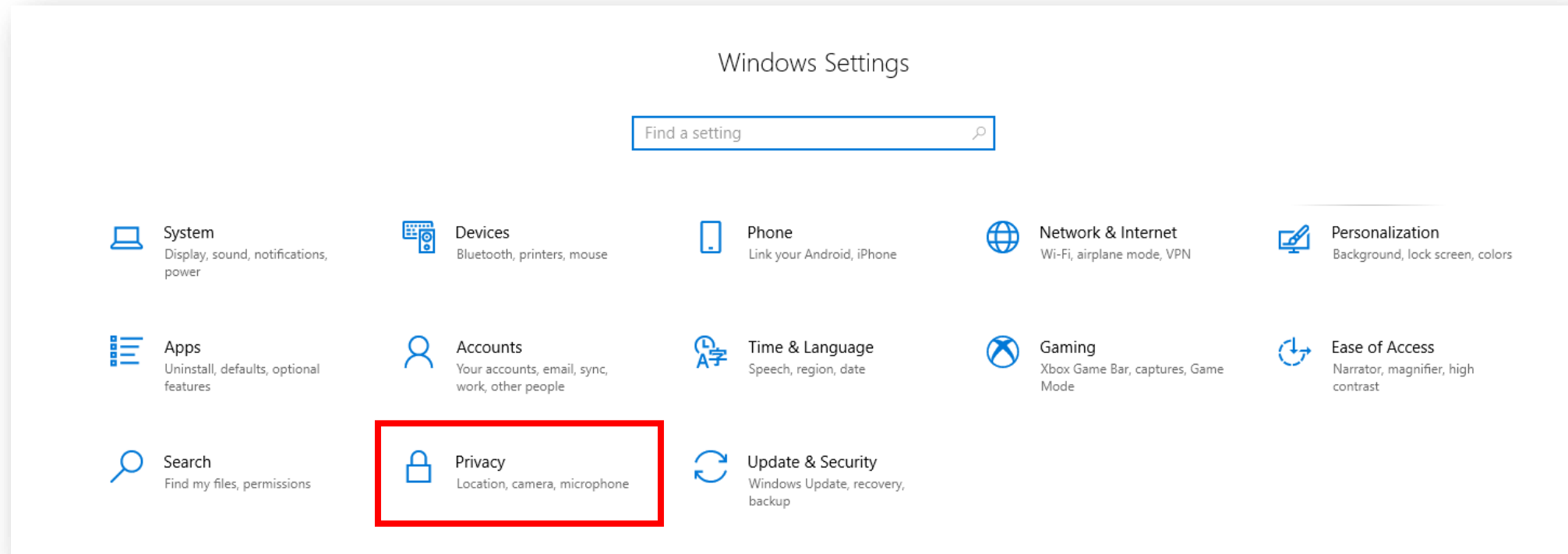
