Here is a brief description of the different components of the **General Dashboard**:

A

Allows you to filter exam records by attempts.

B

Allows you to select the days you want to filter the report. By clicking on "**Select days**", a calendar will be displayed where you can choose the corresponding dates.

C

You can search by **username** or do a full search just by clicking the **Search** button.

D

Using the "**Face Verification**" graph, you can view the overall percentages of authentications that were successful, failed, and displayed a warning.

E

Through the "**Evaluation Tracking**" section, you will be able to view the overall amount of time the students spent outside the SUMADI window

F

On the "**Facial Emotions**" graph, you will show the overall percentage of facial emotions made by the student during the exam.

G

Using the "**Image Quality**" section, show a summary of the capture quality of each student's images. Contemplating brightness and contrast percentages captured with their webcams.

- Through the CSV button, you can download a report, containing the complete report of the students in an exam.
- In the header, the facial verification of each student is detailed in percentages, allowing the records to be filtered in an ascending way.
- By clicking on the student's name, their activity report will be displayed.
