

How to review a candidate's audio recording



- 1 When you enter the candidate's report area, you will be able to view the five sections into which the report is divided. Proceed to the **Audio** section.

A Within the “**Audio**” tab you will find the “**Summary/Resume**” section, which provides information on the Recording Date, Total Audios and Total Recorded Time.





